

## Aviation Security

Aviation Security is applicable to all airline personnel, airport fire service staff, aircraft maintenance staff, air traffic control unit staff, flight and cabin crew, retail outlet staff, construction workers, and any person who works at an airport or has access to the airside or security restricted areas on a regular basis or short-term period.

The AVSEC training component is aligned to CAA requirements.

**Initials, Recurrent and Refresher Training is offered for this module.  
Requires 90% pass mark on final examination.**

Aviation Security Training will include but is not limited to the following modules:

### **Module 1**

Introduce trainees to civil aviation industry  
Explain the role of CAA, airport, airline and cargo section in aviation and aviation security

### **Module 2**

Explain universal threat to civil aviation  
Differentiate various threats

### **Module 3**

Define general security practices at airports

### **Module 4**

Explain the difference between non-restricted and restricted area.  
Move about an airport, complying with the airport security rules.  
Requirements and control measures for accessing non-restricted and restricted areas of the airport.

### **Module 5**

Threat caused by unauthorized access.  
Recognize unusual behaviour at airports.  
Specify the action to be taken when a "suspect" item is located.  
Explain and identify suspect explosive devices, and weapons.

### **Module 6**

Define and classify prohibited items on board the aircraft.  
Basic skills of dealing with disruptive passengers on board the aircraft.

### **Module 7**

Different types of airport emergency procedures.
